Description of weather over period covered:

Mid 80s, Sunny and clear sky.

Activities:

Tyson Waag, P.E. with Stantec arrived on site to view the erosion concerns with Pond D and Pond E. The District's pond maintenance vendor presented concerns of erosion at the March board meeting. The observation began at Pond D and there were several spots where erosion is occurring. The erosion was not severe, and grass was growing at each spot. For most of the areas that were eroding, the resident homes had gutter systems and downspouts. The downspouts create a point source of water flow instead of sheet flow over an entire section of roof. Normally, the sheet flow off the roof has a larger area for infiltration, whereas the point source discharges the entire amount of water in one location, which can increase the likelihood for erosion to occur. This was not for every case of erosion but can explain much of the examples observed.

One last thing to mention, several residents along Pond D have pools and illicit discharge from residents can also be a contributing factor to the erosion that is occurring. This was not personal observed but could be happing in some cases. Residents can discharge their pools into or toward the ponds and can be a contributing factor to pond bank erosion. Educational documentation has been provided on illicit discharge to be distributed to the community.

At Pond E, an observation was conducted of the south and west shoreline and the situation was similar to Pond D with one exception. Much of the erosion can be attributed to downspout erosion and the one exception was severe erosion at the back side of a Mitered End Section (MES) drain outlet. Water has come into contact with the back side of the concrete slab associated with the MES drain and eroded around and underneath the concrete edge. The storm system itself is intact, in good working order and the current erosion has no effect on the operation of the system. The concrete slab is intended to help with erosion and stop water from eroding around the pipe outlet but can also cause unintentional erosion on the back side of the concrete slab. The north and west side of the pond are in excellent condition.

Required actions and issues observed at inspection:

At this time, the District Engineer, Tyson Waag, P.E., would recommend:

- 1. That District provide their residence with educational information on how to help dissipate the water coming from their downspouts. A few residences had their gutter systems piped out to the roadway instead of releasing at the downspout end (Seen in photo gallery).
- 2. That the District seek proposals to repair the erosion at the banks edge and to implement the 2017 pond slope maintenance program provided in the educational documentation. Specifically pertaining to the "No mow bank slope zone" to ensure increased pond bank stabilization.

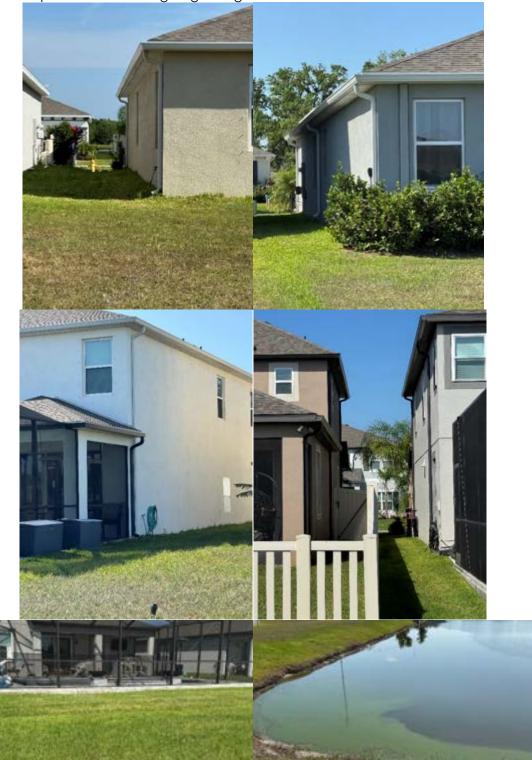

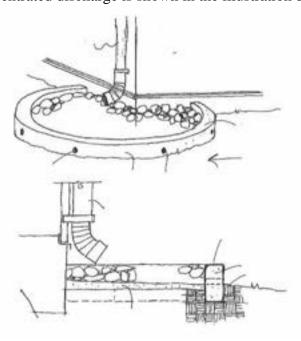
STORMWATER POND SLOPE EROSION

The slopes of the community's stormwater ponds must be maintained with proper vegetation in order to control and prevent *erosion*, or loss of the soil. Erosion of the slopes can be extremely expensive to repair and can sometimes also add unwanted sediment to the water that can negatively affect the water quality in the pond. In addition, eroded banks make it difficult to access and maintain the ponds and unchecked erosion may cause damage to the properties of homeowners next to the affected pond.

The slopes are susceptible to erosion due to

- wave action in the ponds
- the normal fluctuation of the groundwater levels between the rainy and dry seasons
- direct discharge of water from roofs or drains, such as through a roof downspout, a pool overflow pipe, or a water conditioner outflow pipe, that is very concentrated and can carry away soil in its path
- direct discharges from pool drains and water conditioners that contain chemicals such as chlorine or salt that can kill the grass and/or plants that keep the soil in place
- lack of grass and/or plants since vegetation helps keep the soil in place.

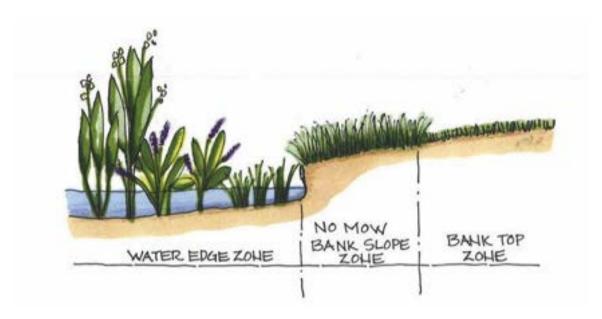
Discharges of water from roofs, pools, and water conditioners can significantly damage pond berms and slopes due to the quality of the water and the concentrated flow of water. Residents who have, or plan to create, a concentrated discharge of water must contact the CDD office to discuss ways to reduce the erosion potential. One way to avoid a concentrated discharge is shown in the illustration below:



It is also very important for vegetation to be established and maintained, on both private and CDD properties, within the pond berms and slopes so that bare soil doesn't lead to erosion. Any aquatic plants that the CDD may plant along the pond slopes should be protected to help stabilize the pond slope along and below the grass line and normal water level.

The District (*CDD*) performs regular inspections of the ponds to assess their conditions and identify any areas that have eroded or show potential for erosion. These areas are then scheduled for appropriate maintenance.

The CDD is implementing a new pond slope maintenance program in 2017 in accordance with guidelines from the University of Florida/IFAS Environmental Horticulture Department's Center for Landscape Conservation and Ecology. The program will use a Moderate to Gentle Slope with a cut bank for the ponds. Turf is planted to the water's edge and a no-mow zone will be established around the perimeter of the ponds. The no-mow strip will be groomed appropriately by the district's landscape maintenance company and will be left taller than a lawn. Homeowners must not mow, nor allow their landscape companies to mow, in the no-mow zone as this interferes with the proper functioning of the system. The following illustration provides more detail:

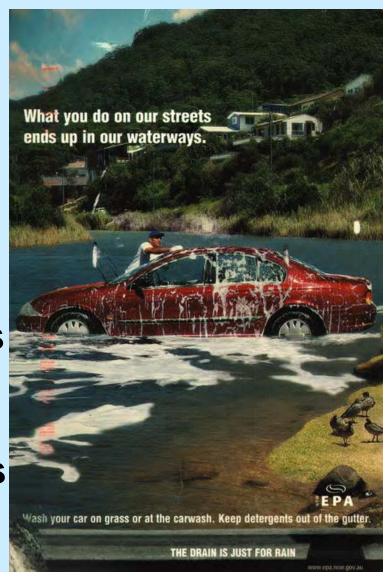

ILLICIT DISCHARGES ARE...

Illegal Dumping

Discharge of pollutants or non-stormwater materials into the storm sewer system

- Washing machine discharge

Spill Response Procedures

Information needed when reporting a spill

- Name, address and phone number of person reporting the spill
- Name, address and phone number of responsible party for the discharge (if known)
- Date and time of the spill and status of spill (ongoing or ceased)
- Estimated amount of the spill
- Location or address of the spill
- Source or cause of the spill
- Description of area affected by the spill
- Provide as much information as possible

What to look for – common signs of illicit discharges



Common Signs of Discharges

- Staining from paints or solvents on outfalls pipes, inlets and grates, and around pond bank
- Turbidity, oil/gas sheen, foam and/or suds
- Abandoned oil and gas containers, barrels, and paint cans
- Discoloration of water or vegetation
- Floatables and debris
- Pungent odors or other smells







Oil / Gas

- Recognized as a sheen on the water = rainbow
- Natural sheens may be differentiated from an oil/gas sheen by swirling the sheen around in the water. If it re-attaches, the sheen is oil/gas.



Foams / Detergents

- Products used to wash boats/vehicles/buildings may include chlorine, phosphates and ammonia.
- These products often enter lakes and streams as a result of improperly connected car washes or washing machines.

BAY COUNTY- After a three month investigation, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) law enforcement agents last week arrested a man with causing pollution, a third degree felony punishable by up to five years in prison and a fine of up to \$10,000. Thomas Bodie, who was arrested after clearing and filling approximately 10 acres of state jurisdictional wetlands, was also charged with failing to obtain a permit, a misdemeanor punishable by up to one year in jail and a fine of up to \$1,000.

Mid 70s, Sunny and clear sky.

Activities:

Tyson Waag, P.E. with Stantec arrived on site to view the dog park at the corner of Willow Grove Dr. and Sage Hollow Ave. The resident at Lot 103 has concerns with the drainage from the dog park flowing to his yard. Walking the entire dog park, the lot is graded from the back of the park (east) to the roadway (west) with the highest point at the northeast corner of the lot sloping to the southwest (See excerpt from as-built plans below). The lots behind the dog park to the east and behind the resident's home to the east are graded from the back of the lots from the west to the east out to the roadway. Observing the space between the resident's home and the dog park, the designed swale is in place and drains to the street. Observing the CDD maintained space between the concerned resident's lot and resident lots behind their home, the space is graded per plan and slopes slightly towards the concerned resident's lot and out to Pond D. Reviewing the ownership mapping the dog park and between the residents lots is maintained by the CDD. According to the permitted plans and the as-built plans, the grading is built to plan and within the standard margin of error. All of the lots are slopping and graded per plan. The only observation worth mentioning was that the southeast corner of the park dipped slightly and appears to send some water away from the dog park, but onto CDD property. The grass is browning in that area.

Required actions and issues observed at inspection:

At this time, the District Engineer, Tyson Waag, P.E., would recommend that the district monitors the area and request that the resident provides further detail and evidence that the dog park is causing ponding and a drainage issue onto his property.

REVENUES

Interest-Investments

The District earns interest on its operating accounts.

Operations & Maintenance Assessments - On Roll

The District will levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all the assessable property within the District to pay for the operating expenditures during the Fiscal Year. The collection will be provided by the Tax Collector pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, which is the Uniform Collection Methodology.

Developer Contributions

The district will direct bill and collect non-ad valorem assessments on assessable property in order to pay for the debt service expenditures during the fiscal year.

Other Miscellaneous Revenues

Additional revenue sources not otherwise specified by other categories.

Special Assessments-Discounts

Per Section 197.162, Florida Statutes, discounts are allowed for early payment of assessments only when collected by the Tax Collector. The budgeted amount for the fiscal year is calculated at 4% of the anticipated Non-Ad Valorem assessments.

EXPENDITURES

Financial and Administrative

Supervisor Fees

Chapter 190 of the Florida Statutes allows for members of the Board of Supervisors to be compensated \$200 per meeting at which they are in attendance. The amount for the Fiscal Year is based upon four supervisors attending 14 meetings.

Onsite Staff

The district may incur expenses for employees or other staff members needed for recreational facilities such as clubhouse staff.

District Management

The District retains the services of a consulting manager, who is responsible for the daily administration of the District's business, including any and all financial work related to the Bond Funds and Operating Funds of the District, and preparation of the minutes of the Board of Supervisors. In addition, the District Manager prepares the Annual Budget(s), implements all policies of the Board of Supervisors and attends all meetings of the Board of Supervisors.

Field Management

The District has a contract with Inframark Infrastructure Management Services. for services in the administration and operation of the Property and its contractors.

Administration

The District receives Management, Accounting and Administrative services as part of a Management Agreement with Inframark Infrastructure Management Services.

Financial and Administrative (continued)

Recording Secretary

Inframark provides recording services with near verbatim minutes.

Construction Accounting

Accounting services as described within the Accounting Services but specifically regarding construction.

Financial/Revenue Collections

Service includes all functions necessary for the timely billing and collection and reporting of District assessments in order to ensure adequate funds to meet the District's debt service and operations and maintenance obligations. These services include, but are not limited to, assessment roll preparation and certification, direct billings and funding request processing as well as responding to property owner questions regarding District assessments. This line item also includes the fees incurred for a collection agent to collect the funds for the principal and interest payment for its short-term bond issues and any other bond related collection needs. These funds are collected as prescribed in the Trust Indenture. The Collection Agent also provides for the release of liens on property after the full collection of bond debt levied on particular properties.

Rentals and Leases

The anticipated cost of rental expenses including but not limited to renting meeting room space for district board meetings.

Data Storage

Cost of server maintenance and technical support for CDD related IT needs.

Accounting Services

Services including the preparation and delivery of the District's financial statements in accordance with Governmental Accounting Standards, accounts payable and accounts receivable functions, asset tracking, investment tracking, capital program administration and requisition processing, filing of annual reports required by the State of Florida and monitoring of trust account activity.

Dissemination Agent/Reporting

The District is required by the Securities and Exchange Commission to comply with rule 15c2-12(b)-(5), which relates to additional reporting requirements for unrelated bond issues. The budgeted amount for the fiscal year is based on standard fees charged for this service.

Website Administration Services

The cost of web hosting and regular maintenance of the District's website by Inframark Management Services.

District Engineer

The District's engineer provides general engineering services to the District, i.e., attendance and preparation for board meetings when requested, review of invoices, and other specifically requested assignments.

District Counsel

The District's attorney provides general legal services to the District, i.e., attendance and preparation for Board meetings, review of contracts, agreements, resolutions, and other research as directed or requested by the BOS District Manager.

Trustee Fees

The District pays US Bank an annual fee for trustee services on the Series 2014 and Series 2015 Bonds. The budgeted amount for the fiscal year is based on previous year plus any out-of-pocket expenses.

Financial and Administrative (continued)

Auditing Services

The District is required to conduct an annual audit of its financial records by an Independent Certified Public Accounting Firm. The budgeted amount for the fiscal year is an estimate based on prior year costs.

Postage, Phone, Faxes, Copies

This item refers to the cost of materials and service to produce agendas and conduct day-to-day business of the District.

Mailings

Copies used in the preparation of agenda packages, required mailings, and other special projects.

Professional Services – Arbitrage Rebate

The District is required to annually calculate the arbitrage rebate liability on its Series 2013A and 2020 bonds.

Legal Advertising

The District is required to advertise various notices for monthly Board meetings and other public hearings in the newspaper of general circulation.

Bank Fees

This represents the cost of bank charges and other related expenses that are incurred during the year.

Dues, Licenses and Fees

This represents the cost of the District's operating license as well as the cost of memberships in necessary organizations.

Onsite Office Supplies

This represents the cost of supplies used to prepare agenda packages, create required mailings, and perform other special projects. The budget for this line item also includes the cost for supplies in the District office.

Website ADA Compliance

Cost of maintaining district website's compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

Disclosure Report

On a quarterly and annual basis, disclosure of relevant district information is provided to the Muni Council, as required within the bond indentures.

Annual Stormwater Report

Cost to produce annual report on CDD stormwater infrastructure.

Miscellaneous Administrative

All other administrative costs not otherwise specified above.

Insurance

Insurance-General Liability

The District's General Liability & Public Officials Liability Insurance policy is with Egis Insurance Advisors, LLC. The budgeted amount allows for a projected increase in the premium.

Public Officials Insurance

The District will incur expenditures for public officials' liability insurance for the Board and Staff and may incur a 10% premium increase.

Property & Casualty Insurance

The District will incur fees to insure items owned by the district for its property needs.

Deductible

District's share of expenses for insured property when a claim is filed.
